The Problem

The primary health care system is fragmented and lacks strong, integrated GP led care at its core. Significant access barriers exist for people trying to navigate the system, particularly those at risk of poor health outcomes.

These barriers contribute to more than 62,000 Western Australians presenting at hospital emergency departments each year, whose care would be best managed through a co-ordinated and responsive primary health care system.




Our Solution

PLAN AND COMMISSION for quality cost effective services that are sustainable and lead to better health outcomes for people with complex chronic conditions. Engage Clinicians and Community in commissioning services that meet priority needs and reduce potentially preventable hospitalisations.
