

GP Palliative Approach Workshop

The Program of Experience in the Palliative Approach (PEPA) provides opportunities for the primary health care workforce to improve confidence and develop knowledge and skills in working with people with palliative care needs. The Department of Health has provided funding for PEPA to work with PHNs to deliver a Palliative Approach Workshop for GPs by the end of 2017.
