The HLGP Role

We're currently seeking a forward thinking, innovative General Practitioner (GP) for our newly created Hospital Liaison GP position located in the Rockingham Peel Group. Ideally the GP will currently practice within the Rockingham Peel Group catchment area and have a keen interest in continuous improvement to further strengthen the integration between the hospital setting and primary care to improve patient care outcomes.

This is a part time position, of four (4) hours per week on a limited term contract.

The purpose of the Hospital Liaison General Practitioner (HLGP) role is to advise on and contribute to system improvements related to the general practice and hospital interface to optimise the continuum and quality of patient care.

The HLGP acts as a 'change agent' in facilitating cross sector integration and coordination of care between the hospital sector, community and general practice. This position is ideally placed to bring an understanding of and advocacy for primary care into the hospital and health department settings.

About you – Selection Criteria

The successful candidate will meet the following selection criteria:

- Registered Medical Practitioner with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA).
- Currently in active General Practice or been in active General Practice in the previous three years, primarily in the geographical area of the hospital/health service;
- High level interpersonal and communication skills, both oral and written, and the ability to work with a diverse range of stakeholders;
- Highly developed organisational skills;
- Demonstrated commitment to embedding quality improvement activities into general practice to improve patient outcomes;
- Knowledge of health systems in the Western Australian context.
