

Information for psychologists, other health professionals and non-health professionals

HealthPathways WA is a web-based portal with condition-specific 'pathways'. Each pathway supports clinicians with assessment, management and local referral information. This includes WA health services directory with listings of public, private and other low-cost health services. The HealthPathways site is designed to be used at point of care primarily by general practitioners but is also available to other health professionals including psychologists. The secure portal is not for use by patients, however there will be appropriate local resources to provide to patients.

HealthPathways team is now constantly working on updating information on health service (including mental health) affected by the current COVID-19 situation and adding patient resources (including mental health) specific to COVID-19.
