

Quick Reference Guide

Red Flags

▶ Clinician Assist WA red flags signal the most serious clinical risks that are easily missed.

Practice point

A reinforcement of a clinical content aspect which may be new or overlooked.

Clinical editor's note

A brief note included by the Clinical Editor when new or temporary information needs to be highlighted and has yet to be incorporated into the pathway (where applicable).

⚠ Pages not adapted to Western Australia (WA)

- Pages that have not been adapted to WA are indicated with an orange background.
- These pages appear in the table of contents as a grey link and will be flagged in your search results as not yet adapted.
- These pages may contain useful condition-management information, use your clinical judgement as to the appropriateness for use in WA.

SEND FEEDBACK

- Feedback can be provided on any page, at any time using the **Send Feedback** button.
- All clinical feedback is triaged by the team and updates actioned based on urgency.
- Non-clinical feedback (e.g. reporting broken links or updates to service information) is actioned as soon as possible (if required).
